6 Planning Issues

- a 2020/1920 Mrs London's revised development plan: the council are in favour of the revised plans; need clarification of responsibility for servicing of dog bins
- b Tas Valley Mushrooms update: Enforcement Officer Martin Burrows is awaiting paperwork from TVM to regularise outstanding issues at the mushroom plant. To date, conditions have not been met; this was confirmed in a site visit by Andy Baines
- c Planning Enforcement update (for information) South Norfolk will in future send updates on enforcement issues in this parish only

- d Planning Department updates: (for information) South Norfolk and Broadland councils have a joint planning portal; however, for users the portal is exactly the same as before, with only one extra click.
- e late application: 2021/1465 land north of Hill House, The Street, 3-4 bedroom chalet. This was refused as 2012/1232 and an appeal also refused; council OBJECTS
- f 2021/1072 Bracon Ash solar farm: this lies outside the parish and the council have no comments to make
- 7 Highways: traffic speeds and volume (see Public Comment above) The SAM2 is effective in that some drivers slow down when they see it. However, it has been a problem trying to download data. If ClIr Barnes is able to download data from the SAM2 and submit it to PC Barnard, he will get the road safety team involved in looking into possible solutions for the problems being encountered in the village. PC Barnard will also show a presence in the village when time allows, coordinating with ClIr Barnes as to optimum times to do so. PC Barnard will also email ClIr Barnes details of the updated Speedwatch scheme with a view to a possible restart of this in Flordon. He will ensure that any prosecutions in this area are publicised to act as a deterrent.

- **9** Hedge behind Bus Shelter: hedge has collapsed under the weight of ivy; Cllr Webster will investigate with Tony Taplin
- **10** Verge Cutting: NCC policy is now to cut most verges once a year instead of twice. Many verges formerly cut by volunteers are now untended. There was discussion about paying people to cut sections of verge. Councillors will put out a call for volunteers/people prepared to do this work.
